We trust in the inner connection between the person and the world, understanding that each being has a place in the universe and their own role.

We choose simplicity as a way of life and as a guide for healing the planet:

- The earth is a living being, not an object to be measured and dominated.
- Knowledge is not separate from love, emotion, and intuition. True, integrated knowledge transforms reality.
- Consciousness is not exclusive to human beings, rather it belongs to Earth. In the same way, the mind isn't independent of matter, but rather orients and configures it.
- The coming cycle of civilisation displaces the centrality of the human being and includes therefore a new anthropology and a new history of the universe.
- Human destiny is inseparable from the destiny of all other living beings. There is not one time for humans and another for the Earth. We all inhabit the same Time.
- Evolution is not a straight line; species coevolve and interact via cooperation and mutual solidarity. Everything is interrelated and nothing is predetermined.
- Each culture generates a world and a way of knowing it. Hence, cultural pluralism is essential in order to coexist peacefully and for better self-knowledge of human life.
- The way in which we describe ourselves to ourselves, configures reality.
- Freedom is inherent to life.
